2. Students are required to register themselves and upload the required documents with the help of their own unique login ID and password.
3. Respective University Teaching Departments/ Centres/ P.U. Constituent Colleges/ PU Regional Centres are required to verify Scholarship Application Form (Institutional Verification Form) along with supporting documents and also provide the **Annual Course Fee detail in the following format for their respective courses:**

Admission Fee (Annually)	Rs.

4. Further the hardcopies of Scholarship application form along with supporting documents are to be forwarded to the Scholarship section, SC/ST Cell, Aruna Ranjit Chandra Hall, 1st Floor, Room No.216 for approval and further processing.
5. The following documents (duly signed by the candidates) is mandatory to be attached for each and every kind of scholarship, in addition to documents required for a particular scholarship:
 - a. Student Photo. (Mandatory)
 - b. Institution Verification Form. (Mandatory)
 - c. In case of Fresh: Self Attested Certificate of 'Previous Academic Mark sheet' as filled in Form. (Mandatory)
 - d. In case of Renewal: Self-attested Certificate of Previous Year Marksheet as filled in the Form. (Mandatory)
 - e. Fee Receipt of current course yearly. (Mandatory)
 - f. Proof of Bank Account in the name of student. (Mandatory) linked with Aadhar Card
 - g. Aadhaar Card (Mandatory)
 - h. Residential Certificate. (Mandatory)

It is also further advised to visit regularly on the website www.scholarships.gov.in for new introduced scholarships by the Govt. of India from time to time, so that maximum number of students of the university can get the benefit by applying for scholarships according to their eligibility.
